This worksheet is for those who prefer to work on paper before filling out the online report, and those who choose not to use the online system.

INTRODUCTION

Please realize that for the purposes of this report, the working definition of a 'Congregation' is more broad than that of an established parish. A Congregation is "a unique worshiping community where the Word is preached and the sacraments are celebrated." In the past, some congregations have not reported when they could have because they assumed that they needed to be fully independent. There are 5 sections to the Congregational Report: Contact, Membership, Worship, Stewardship, and Ministry. You can use this document as a worksheet and then fill in the results for your congregation online, or you can send the completed report to the provincial office by mail or fax.

The total income used for operations including pledges, plate, regular offerings; as well as principal or interest from savings and trusts used for operations.

Include capital funds and other non-operating designated funds.

If you are supporting a couple or family, please include each individual in the total. (Ex. St. John's supports Mr. and Mrs. Smith and their three children as missionaries in Uganda. They also support Mr. Jones, a missionary in Asia. St. John's total would be 6.)

69) How many of those Cross-Cultural Workers/Missionaries have been sent out from your church with a long-term partnership?

The previous question asked about the total number of missionaries a congregation supports including those raised up from within their congregation, and those whose home church is another congregation. This question is asking about which of those missionaries have been raised up from within your congregation. A "long term partnership" is defined as a worker whose intention is to remain overseas for at least 3 years.

Note: A congregation is defined as a unique worshipping community where the scriptures are taught and the sacraments are celebrated. A parish may consist of more than one congregation. If a congregation begins a service designed for a specific age demographic or ethnic group this is a new congregation. For example, if a primarily Caucasian congregation supports a new service for Spanish speakers this is a new congregation. If a congregation begins a weekly service at an assisted living facility this is a congregation. If a congregation adds a spoken Rite I service prior to it's contemporary Rite II service this is NOT a new congregation.
